OVERVIEW

California (**CDE Gifted and Talented Education (GATE)**) operates under the **Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)** — decisions about gifted identification practices, services, and program design are made at the **local district level**. With one of the nation's most diverse student populations, California emphasizes **equity, multiple measures, and local control** in serving advanced learners. Districts incorporate GATE priorities into their **Local Control and Accountability Plans (LCAPs)**.

CALIFORNIA'S G/T FRAMEWORK IN CONTEXT

California's framework is **locally-driven rather than state-mandated**, but the CDE provides statewide guidance and resources. LCFF replaced the previous categorical GATE funding stream — districts now integrate gifted services into their LCAP goals and comprehensive district plans. This creates maximum flexibility across California's ~1,000 districts but also places responsibility on each district for program design and accountability.
